Message for Current Year 2 Parents - Year 3 Sleepover on Thursday 12th July 2018

When your child joins Year 3 in July for their transition weeks, they are invited to attend a sleep-over in school as part of their topic on Scavengers and Settlers on **Thursday 12th July 2018**. Children will be working in the forest area to build a shelter using only what they have been provided with from school and what they can find in the forest area. We will have a campfire; after this the children will sleep in the school hall, ready to bunk down for the night.

On **Thursday 12th July**, you need to pick your child up from school as normal and return them to school at 18:30, wearing suitable clothes to wear in the forest area (enter school via middle gate). As Friday 13th July is a school day, breakfast will be provided in school and the children will then go to their classes at 08:45 to start their school day.

Cost of this will be £5 to help towards breakfast cost and resources.

Listed below are the items you will need to provide for your child, remembering that they are Scavengers! **Please label ALL items, clearly.**

Suitable clothing for the forest area and a waterproof coat

School Uniform (for Friday)

Toothbrush and toothpaste.

Change of underwear.

Pyjamas

Sleeping bag: a duvet is fine if you don't have a sleeping bag

Plastic cup/mug

Torch (labelled with name)

A large named plastic bag, to pack the clothes they have worn on Thursday evening.

If your child will require any medication during the sleep-over, please speak to their new class teacher once they have moved into Year 3.

This is a great opportunity for your children to enjoy problem solving, working as a team, survival, leadership and having fun which contributes to their understanding of this unit of work. Please complete the slip below and return with £5 cash, in a clearly labelled envelope, to school by **Monday 2nd July 2018**
