Dear Parents of Children attending JCA Condover Hall 10th – 11st April 2019

Please find attached a Parent Consent Form which needs to be completed and returned to school by **Friday 1st February 2019** – child's **NHS number must be completed**. If we do not receive this form your child will not be able to attend this trip. If you have any money outstanding this **MUST** be paid by Thursday 28th February 2019, unless you have already made an agreement with Ms Cope. If we do not receive payment your child's place may be cancelled. Please speak to Ms Cope immediately if you have any concerns over this.

Also attached is a suggested kit list for the trip.

We suggest that you fit all of the equipment that your child is bringing in one bag, as they will have to carry their own bag. **Please DO NOT send an enormous bag as your child will be carrying their OWN luggage**. We suggest that your child packs the bag with you so that they know what is in there. Please ensure that all clothing is labelled. They do not need a sleeping bag. Due to the time of year, we suggest **layers**. Make sure your child has a vest/t-shirt/sweatshirt or jumper and jacket for each day. We will wear plenty of **layers**, if we get too warm we can take some off.

Please ensure that girls hair is braided or tied up as they are not allowed to do the activities with their hair loose.

Please note:


- No electrical equipment to be taken away.
- No mobile phones allowed.
- No need for Pocket Money
- No Sweets

The coach will leave school at approximately 10.30am **Wednesday 10th April** and will return on **Thursday 11th April** at approximately 3.00pm.

We will message parents though parentmail to confirm arrival at Condover Hall and send out regular twitter updates (please note that we can not guarantee that all children will be Tweeted as phone signal is particularly poor at Condover Hall). If there are any delays on the return journey we will notify you again by parentmail with any information we have therefore please ensure all your contact information at school are correct.

Small Towel – due to timings they will only have time to have a wash	
Plastic bottle for drinks and a small rucksack to carry it in, they need these all day	
Labelled plastic bags for wet items & dirty laundry

- children need to bring practical activity clothing and need to wear layers	
- non-fashion items.	
- No stringy vests/tops in case of really hot weather and safety issues relating to these items getting caught.
