

Life to the Full-RSHE Parental Questionnaire Spring 2023

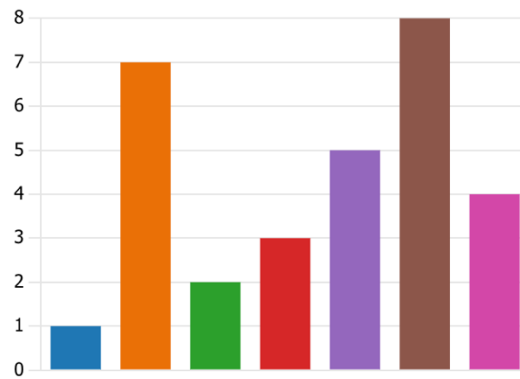

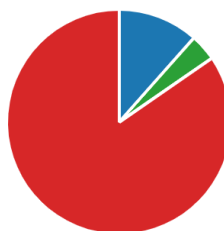
